FFA is where I gained much of my leadership skills through the offices I held, speaking events I participated in, and animals I showed and took care of. I was also very involved in my church. After high school, I graduated from Texas Tech University with a Bachelor’s in Early Childhood Education. I immediately began teaching fourth grade and then moved to second grade. While teaching, I went back to school and got my Master’s in Educational Administration from Lamar University. After nine years of teaching, I moved into a Reading Instructional Specialist position, and then became an Elementary Assistant Principal, at the same school I spent the first nine years teaching. I absolutely love being in education and know that is what I have been called to do.

Jeremy – I also grew up in a small town with my mom, dad, and two younger brothers. We lived in the country so my brothers and I spent a lot of time together playing on our family farm.
